Grand Final day sees 4 Premier Clubs represented throughout the grades. Wanderers and Merewether Carlton have both achieved the impressive feat of achieving grand final appearances in 3 out of a possible 4 being played on the last Saturday in September. Hamilton and Maitland are the other Clubs who have earned a Grand Final appearance.

The Premier 1 Grand Final sees a rematch of last year's grand final fixture between Hamilton v Wanderers. An analysis of the results between the two sides over the last 2 seasons (2015 and 2016 seasons) makes you realise how 'neck and neck' these two sides really are (Hamilton have a 5:1 win/loss ratio however a total accumulated winning margin of only 27 points over the last 6 games between the sides).
